

WordStorm™

Word Prediction Program for Fusion Version 2.2

Features

- Learn as you write
- Automatic spacing
- Automatic capitalization
- Adjustable dictionary size
- Adjustable word list size (6 or 9 words)
- Phonetic options
- Topic specific word lists
- Read back

To operate:

Open a file, press the Word Pred key and begin typing. Press Esc to exit. To view WordStorm program options press the Menu key; select Predict, then arrow down to Prediction Setup. To type numbers, hold down the Alt key.

Learn as you write

WordStorm will learn your word preference as you write. Previously used words become first options in the Word Prediction list. If you misspell a word, simply correct or delete that word in your file to correct the WordStorm option list.

Automatic spacing

WordStorm will automatically place a space after each word selected. Commas, periods and other end punctuation will automatically backspace into proper location and then auto-space.

Automatic capitalization

Wordstorm will automatically capitalize the first word in each sentence.

Adjustable dictionary size

You can select the size of the prediction list. Within a file press the Menu key; select Predict, then arrow down to Prediction Setup. You can select from four lists: 1,000, 3,000, 8,000 and the entire dictionary (80,000 words).

Adjustable word list size (6 or 9 words)

Within a file, press the Menu key. Select Predict, then arrow down to Prediction Setup.

Phonetic options

WordStorm will offer word choices based upon phonetically misspelled input. WordStorm contains a large database of common phonetic misspellings. (If a student were to type in "dur" the option "dirt" will appear in the prediction list. Teachers can add to this phonetic misspelling dictionary).

Topic Specific Word List

Students or educators can install topic specific word lists. Simply create a file on the student desktop or within a folder and name it "vocab". Type in any number of topic related words and those words will appear first within the option list. Example: If the student were writing an essay on the Civil War, a file named vocab would be created and within that file these words would be typed: Abraham, Lincoln, North, South, Gettysburg, Address, slavery, Washington, United, States, etc.

Read back

WordStorm WP options can be heard prior to selection. (Your Fusion unit must be equipped with the Text to Speech option.) Open your file, press the Menu key; select Predict, then arrow down to Prediction Setup. Select *TTS Read Pred.* and arrow to Yes. To hear a word option, simply press the corresponding number. To insert that word press the number again.
